Lower Medical Insurance Claims

Breastfed infants incur lower health costs from fewer doctor visits, hospitalizations, and prescriptions, which helps the company's bottom line when employers subsidize health insurance.

Reduced Absenteeism

Breast milk boosts infants' immune systems and helps protect them from common childhood illnesses - this is particularly true for babies in a childcare environment. One-day absences (to care for a sick child) occur more than twice as often for mothers of formula-fed infants than for those of breastfed infants.

Employers with lactation programs benefit from significantly higher retention rates over the national average and reduced recruitment, hiring, and training costs.
