


Physician Selection

Outcomes (Quality): Step 1

- Condition Specific (Performance treating certain conditions)
- Risk Adjusted (adjustments made for patient specific pre-existing conditions and co-morbidities)
- Performance vs peers (to ID top 20%)

Efficiency (Cost): Step 2

- Total cost of care
- Expected vs Realized
- Based on 90 day episodes
- Performance vs peers treating similar conditions/members





Data in Practice: A Data-Informed Care Journey

Example metrics used and captured for a simple care journey with two referrals

Outreach

Icon targets outreach to members with high potential to benefit from support

Metrics Used:

- Past MSK diagnoses
- "Indicator" services, e.g. imaging, PT
- Demographics

Intake

Icon captures key demographic and comorbidity information

Metrics Captured:

- Demographics
- Relevant comorbidities

Referral to MD

Icon refers to a provider that is high quality, low cost, and matched to member needs

Referral to PT

Icon must select a therapist that only practices in one-on-one PT sessions
