

# 1. The Problem

It's not GLP-1s. It's obesity given its prevalence, cost, and stigma.

- Obesity affects over 40% of US adults and is expected to affect 60% by 2035.
- Individuals with obesity drive 2x the health care costs of peers with normal BMI.
- Rapid GLP-1 adoption is driving skyrocketing Rx spend often without wraparound lifestyle and behavioral support with some employers noting 500%+ growth in 2023.
- "GLP-1s for all" solutions open broad usage and result in high initial costs.

- 14% of patients were diagnosed with weight-related conditions that had previously gone untreated.
