GI conditions affect **1 in 4 people**¹



GI spend is higher than heart disease and mental health²

GI is a top cost driver but the coding system is complex and can hide the full impact of GI on spend.

Without Multidisciplinary GI Care vs **With Oshi Multidisciplinary GI Care**

No standard measurement of symptom control vs **92%** of Oshi members achieve symptom control within 4 months

\$22,866 costs for patients seeking GI care, including high ER utilization, per year vs **\$10,292 savings** in all-cause healthcare costs per patient in 6 months

1 month for appointment with GI specialist⁴ vs **5 days for appointment** with full care team

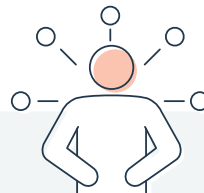
