Our team of clinicians, pharmacists, nutritionists, nurses, behavioral health specialists, and Care Guides have decades of experience and a deep dedication to help our members succeed. If you need advanced care from a partner provider, we will work directly with them to get your results and coordinate your care to provide the best outcomes.

If you experience anything that falls into services that are not covered under the membership, such as hospitalization, surgery, cancer treatment, or others, you will need to use your health insurance plan. Even then, we can help by coordinating care services like imaging, durable goods, or testing to help save you time and money. You also have access to our generic prescription formulary of over 200 medications at no extra cost, which is available to you no matter what doctor prescribes the medicine.

As a member, you also receive health coaching. This includes help with issues like smoking cessation, weight loss, mindfulness, good sleep habits, and healthy living. This is our approach to building healthcare with people at the center where we focus not just on treating illness but on building health.

## **BEHAVIORAL HEALTH**

Behavioral health care at PeopleOne Health focuses on how your daily habits and actions are impacting your mental and physical health. Our goal is to address our members' health from a 360-degree perspective. Your PeopleOne Health care team is committed to patient centered-care, approaching you with solutions that address your specific needs, and providing you with more individualized care than a typical doctor's office.

#### So, what does this look like for you as a member?

Each time you visit your primary care provider you'll be greeted by one of our Care Guides, who will invite you to answer questions that help us best understand you. We want to know how you are feeling and what you are doing to cope with the stressors of life. Research shows that **only about 10% of patients with depression receive appropriate care** when visiting their primary health care provider, and we know we can do better. We'll explore your sleep, mood, diet, drug/alcohol use and exercise habits, through an evidence based process known as **SBIRT** (**S**creening, **B**rief Intervention and **R**eferral to **T**reatment). This comprehensive and integrated public health approach allows your PeopleOne Health provider to understand more about your mental and physical health and provide you with the right services at the right time.

Whether at home, at work, or in our offices, you and your family will have access to our team of emotional well-being experts who are here to offer you various levels of support. Your primary care physician, social worker, wellness coach, care guide, lab technician, pharmacist and network of specialists will work closely together to offer you the following services:

- Therapy (virtual or in-person)
- Medication evaluation
- Medication management
- Referrals to substance use treatment programming
- Social determinants of health screenings

PeopleOne Health recognizes there are many pathways to well-being and recovery, so we have established partnerships in the community to meet your needs for anything that we don't provide in-house. ## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### When should I contact my PeopleOne Health care team?

You should check with your PeopleOne Health care team FIRST for non-emergency medical needs. Since we can meet 85-90% of your medical needs, chances are we can help or we can set up referrals to our Partner Providers to get you the right care.

#### How soon can I get an appointment?

We offer same-day and next-day sick visits. We see patients for regular appointments within 30 days, and a physician is available 24/7 via phone for your urgent needs as well. We also offer appointments via telemedicine.

#### What if I need to speak to someone after hours?

PeopleOne Health offices offer 24/7 physician support. A physician is available after hours via phone for your urgent needs.

#### What if I have a chronic medical condition, such as diabetes or hypertension?

Chronically ill patients are placed in risk-reduction programs, which include nurse visits, dietitian visits and extra visits with your PeopleOne Health healthcare provider, ultimately decreasing both the physical and economic burden of chronic diseases.

#### What if something happens when I am traveling and not near my office?

In the event that you are traveling or outside of the service area and in need of medical attention we encourage you to give our office a call. Many minor illnesses or injuries can be diagnosed and treated over the phone or via virtual consultations with our providers without the need to visit the ER or an urgent care facility. In instances where an in-person evaluation or treatment may be necessary, we will work with you to locate an appropriate urgent care facility near you. If you are seen, this will initiate the usage of your insurance plan and out-of-pocket costs may be incurred.

\*If you are having a life-threatening emergency, we urge you to call 9-1-1 immediately.\*

#### Are medications and labs really covered?

Yes. PeopleOne Health offers a generic prescription formulary of over 200 medications that are covered through the membership. Several medications are kept right in the office - mostly for acute care reasons, including antibiotics, antihistamines, steroids, anti-inflammatories - and can be dispensed at the time of your visit for you to take home with you. Members are encouraged to view the generic formulary included with this guide and on our website (peopleonehealth.com/rx-benefits) for the most current formulary.

PeopleOne Health members can also have routine lab work done right within our offices, with most basic lab tests covered under the membership. Even if you are seeing another doctor who orders lab work, you can bring that order to your PeopleOne Health office and have your blood drawn there so you do not incur additional costs.
